Her visit lays the foundation for collaborations with several Australian Universities and organizations that would benefit our Faculty and students. Updates on these coming soon!



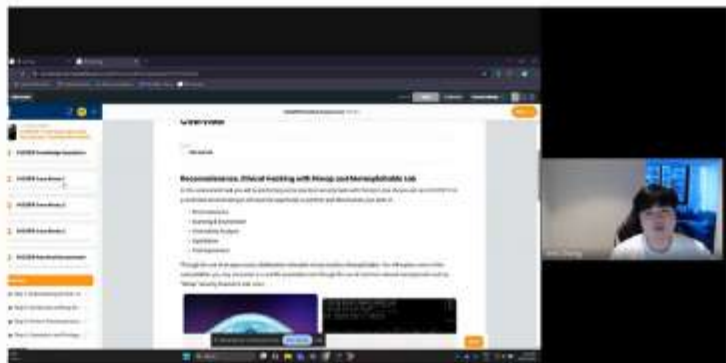
Online session with BSI Learning, Australia on Australian Cybersecurity Qualifications

July 18, 2025

An online session was held with interested BTech students of DYPIU regarding an Australian cybersecurity qualification. This is being offered by BSI Learning with HCL Tech. Ms. Kala Philip, CEO, BSI Learning along with Master Trainer Kris Chung presented the various aspects of the program along with a demo. This qualification would provide students a job ready program for cyber analyst positions in Australia and around the globe. The program is also bundled with Microsoft Azure and Cisco Certified Network Technician international vendor qualifications from HCL Tech to make it a comprehensive program for international mobility.

BSI-HCL is also in discussions with the School of Computer Science, Engineering and Applications to establish the BSI-HCL Australian AI Data and Cyber Center of Practice. BSI will select one University in Maharashtra to house this state of the art Center.

A follow up session will be held in August for all students. Details coming shortly on the date for the session.

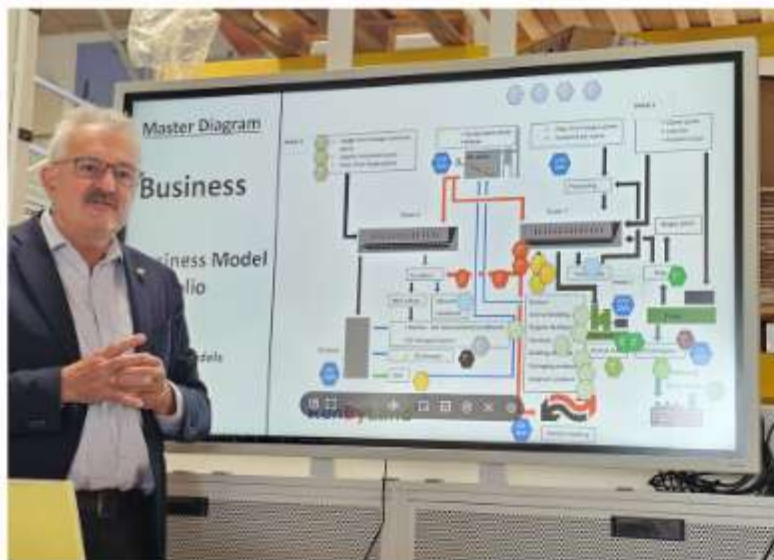


STUDENT INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS
